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## **Section 21 Declaration**

All club members, probationary club members, and guests who do not possess their own firearm certificates are required by law to sign a declaration to the effect that they are not prohibited from possessing a firearm or ammunition by virtue of Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968 as (amended 1997/2014).

It is an offence for someone who is prohibited by Section 21 to have a firearm or ammunition in his or her possession at any time. Section 21 applies to anyone who has been sentenced to a term of imprisonment or to detention in a young offender's institution for three months or more, this also applies a suspended sentence. The period for which they are, prohibited depends on the length of sentence. If the sentence was longer than three years, the prohibition is for life. If the sentence was for three months or more, but less than three years, then the prohibition lasts for five years from the date of release or end of suspended sentence. It is an offence for a person to transfer, let, hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone he or she knows or has reasonable grounds for believing them to be prohibited by Section 21.

## **Section 21 Declaration**

# Persons Prohibited by Section 21 of the Firearms Act from Possessing or Handling Firearms, or Ammunition

Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968 (as amended 1997/2014) prohibits a person from possession of any type of firearm if they have been given a custodial or suspended sentence when convicted of a criminal offence.

If you have received a custodial sentence or suspended sentence of between 3 months and 3 years then you are prohibited for a period of 5 years from the date you are released or end of suspended sentence.

If you have received a custodial sentence or suspended sentence of 3 years or more then you are prohibited for life. This applies to persons sentenced in all parts of the UK including Northern Ireland. Section 29 of the Criminal Justice Act 1972 amended section 21 of the 1968 acts to read, (The prohibition includes detention in a Young Offender Institution.)

(The prohibition may be, lifted on application to the Crown Court, for advice, please consult a solicitor.) Under the Firearms Acts, no conviction may be, considered as 'spent' where applications to possess firearms are concerned and the police will, notify the Club if they feel that a person's record or background would render them unsuitable to possess firearms. It is also an offence for a person to sell or transfer a firearm or ammunition to, or repair, test or prove a firearm or ammunition for, a person whom he/she knows or has reasonable grounds for believing to be, prohibited from having a firearm or ammunition in his/her possession.

The Club membership application form requires you to disclose any conviction or current police investigation, and failure to do so will invalidate your application. Signing the application form also declares that you are not, prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition by virtue of Section 21.

Please note that under Home Office criteria for target clubs, the Club must notify the police of new membership applications. Naturally, the Club has an obligation under the law & to its members to protect its good name, and will not normally accept persons as members who are clearly unsuitable, to be in possession of firearms. Therefore, if you have any convictions or are currently under investigation by the police you must complete the application form honestly in order to avoid subsequent embarrassment or possible prosecution under Section 21 of the Firearms Acts.

At Hemswell Shooting Club, we make every effort to comply with our obligations under the Data Protection Act, along with our legal obligations to the Police & governing authorities.
